**ORDER ON PLAINTIFFS'
MOTION FOR ATTORNEYS'
FEES AND COSTS,
ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES,
AND CLASS REPRESENTATIVES'
COMPENSATION AWARDS**

This matter came before the Court on a Fairness Hearing on August 15, 2024. During the Fairness hearing, the Court considered, among other things, Plaintiffs' Motion for Attorneys' Fees and Costs, Administrative Expenses, and Class Representatives' Compensation Awards. Pursuant to Article 7 of the Settlement Agreement, Defendants do not take any position with respect to this motion and there were no objections to the motion (which was timely filed before the objection deadline) from any Class Member.

Having considered the motion papers, the proposed Settlement Agreement which the Court preliminarily approved on March 5, 2024, the arguments of counsel, and all files, records, and proceedings in this action, and otherwise being fully informed in the premises as to the facts and the law,

It is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. Class Counsel's request for an award of \$1,666,666.67 in attorneys' fees is approved. Having reviewed Class Counsel's application and the applicable legal authorities, the Court finds the requested amount (one-third of the \$5 million Qualified Settlement Fund) to be reasonable and appropriate.

2. Class Counsel's request for litigation expenses in the amount of \$25,683.39 and settlement administration expenses in the amount of \$51,297.00 is approved. The Court has reviewed these expenses and finds that they are reasonable and appropriate given the nature of this action.

3. Plaintiffs' request for class representatives' service awards in the amount of \$5,000 each to Named Plaintiffs Elizabeth Schaf and Thomas Scarber (\$10,000 total) is approved. The Court finds this award to be justified under the facts of this case and consistent with applicable legal authorities.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
